

NAME

XkbAllocIndicatorMaps - Allocates, directly, the *indicators* member of the keyboard description record

SYNOPSIS

Status XkbAllocIndicatorMaps (**variable_type** **xkb*);

ARGUMENTS

xkb keyboard description structure

DESCRIPTION

The *xkb* parameter must point to a valid keyboard description. If it doesn't, *XkbAllocIndicatorMaps* returns a BadMatch error. Otherwise, *XkbAllocIndicatorMaps* allocates and initializes the *indicators* member of the keyboard description record and returns Success. If *XkbAllocIndicatorMaps* was unable to allocate the indicators record, it reports a BadAlloc error.

RETURN VALUES"

Success	The <i>XkbAllocIndicatorMaps</i> function returns Success if it is successful in allocating and initializing the <i>indicators</i> member of the keyboard description record.

DIAGNOSTICS

BadMatch	A compatible version of Xkb was not available in the server or an argument has correct type and range, but is otherwise invalid
BadAlloc	Unable to allocate storage
