abs - integer absolute value function

SYNOPSIS

#include <stdlib.h>
```

abs(int j);
```

DESCRIPTION

The **abs()** function computes the absolute value of the integer *j*.

RETURN VALUES

The **abs()** function returns the absolute value.

The **abs()** function conforms to ISO/IEC 9899:1999 ("ISO C99").

HISTORY

BUGS

The absolute value of the most negative integer remains negative.
