

**NAME**

**acl\_delete\_flag\_np** - delete flags from a flagset

**LIBRARY**

Standard C Library (libc, -lc)

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <sys/types.h>
```

#include <sys/acl.h>
```

**DESCRIPTION**

The **acl\_delete\_flag\_np()** function is a non-portable call that removes specific NFSv4 ACL flags from flagset *flags*.

**RETURN VALUES**

The **acl\_delete\_flag\_np()** function returns the value 0 if successful; otherwise the value -1 is returned and the global variable *errno* is set to indicate the error.

**ERRORS**

The **acl\_delete\_flag\_np()** function fails if:

[EINVAL]           Argument *flagset\_d* is not a valid descriptor for a flagset. Argument *flag* does not contain a valid *acl\_flag\_t* value.
