SYNOPSIS

To compile this driver into the kernel, place the following lines in your kernel configuration file:

device adb

DESCRIPTION

The akbd driver provides support for all keyboards attached to the Apple Desktop Bus (ADB).

HARDWARE

Devices supported by the **akbd** driver include:

- Apple Extended Keyboard
- Apple Keyboard II
- Apple iBook Keyboard
- Apple PowerBook Keyboard

EVENTS

The **akbd** driver sends events to devd(8) for the following events under the **PMU** system:

• Power button - **Button** subsystem, **pressed** type.

SYSCTL VARIABLES

The **akbd** driver supports the following sysctl variable for configuring the Fn keys:

dev.akbd.%d.fn_keys_function_as_primary

Set the Fn keys to be their F-key type as default. A value of 0 causes the F-keys keys to work as special keys by default (abtn(4)) and a value of 1 sets them to behave as F-keys by default.
