# DESCRIPTION

The **at\_quick\_exit()** function registers a cleanup function to be called when the program exits as a result of calling quick\_exit(3). The cleanup functions are called in the reverse order and will not be called if the program exits by calling exit(3), \_Exit(3), or abort(3).

#### **RETURN VALUES**

The **at\_quick\_exit()** function returns the value 0 if successful and a non-zero value on failure.
