

NAME

audit_warn - alert when audit daemon issues warnings

DESCRIPTION

The **audit_warn** script runs when auditd(8) generates warning messages.

The default **audit_warn** is a script whose first parameter is the type of warning; the script appends its arguments to */etc/security/audit_messages*. Administrators may replace this script: a more comprehensive one would take different actions based on the type of warning. For example, a low-space warning could result in an email message being sent to the administrator.
