auditdistd - Audit trail files distribution daemon

SYNOPSIS

auditdistd [-dFhl] [-c config] [-P pidfile]

DESCRIPTION

The **auditdistd** daemon is responsible for distributing audit trail files over a TCP/IP network in a secure and reliable way.

The auditdistd daemon can be started with the following command line arguments:

- -c config Specify an alternative location of the configuration file. The default location is /etc/security/auditdistd.conf. Note: the configuration file may contain passwords. Care should be taken to configure proper permissions on this file (eg. 0600).
- **-d** Print or log debugging information. This option can be specified multiple times to raise the verbosity level.
- **-F** Start the **auditdistd** daemon in the foreground. By default **auditdistd** starts in the background.
- **-h** Print the **auditdistd** usage message.
- -I Start in a launchd-friendly mode, ie. do not use daemon(3).
- **-P** *pidfile* Specify an alternative location of a file where main process PID will be stored. The default location is */var/run/auditdistd.pid*.

FILES

/etc/security/auditdistd.conf The configuration file for **auditdistd**.
/var/run/auditdistd.pid The default location of the **auditdistd** PID file.

EXIT STATUS

Exit status is 0 on success, or one of the values described in sysexits(3) on failure.
