beep - play a beep sound

SYNOPSIS

beep [-**F** frequency] [-**D** duration_ms] [-**r** sample_rate_hz] [-**d** oss_device] [-**g** gain] [-**B**] [-h]

DESCRIPTION

The **beep** utility is used to playback a beep on the soundcard.

The options are as follows:

- **-F** Sets the center frequency of the beep in Hz. The default is 440 Hz.
- **-D** Sets the duration of the beep in milliseconds. The default is 150 ms.
- -d Sets the soundcard to use. The default is /dev/dsp.
- **-r** Sets the soundcard samplerate in Hz. The default is 48000 Hz.
- -g Sets the waveform gain, between 0 and 100 inclusively. The default is 75.
- **-B** Runs the **beep** utility in the background.
- **-h** Display summary of options.
