

NAME

cd9660 - ISO-9660 file system

SYNOPSIS

To link into the kernel:

options CD9660

Alternatively, to load the driver as a module at boot time, place the following line in loader.conf(5):

```
cd9660_load="YES"
```

DESCRIPTION

The **cd9660** driver will permit the FreeBSD kernel to access the cd9660 file system.

EXAMPLES

To mount a **cd9660** volume located on */dev/cd0*:

```
mount -t cd9660 /dev/cd0 /mnt
```

The **cd9660** driver first appeared in 4.4BSD-Lite.
