

NAME

`curl_url_strerror` - return string describing error code

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
const char *curl_url_strerror(CURLUcode errornum);
```

DESCRIPTION

This function returns a string describing the CURLUcode error code passed in the argument *errornum*.

EXAMPLE

```
int main(void)
{
    CURLUcode rc;
    CURLU *url = curl_url();
    rc = curl_url_set(url, CURLUPART_URL, "https://example.com", 0);
    if(rc)
        printf("URL error: %s\n", curl_url_strerror(rc));
    curl_url_cleanup(url);
}
```

RETURN VALUE

A pointer to a null-terminated string.
