**device\_quiet**, **device\_verbose**, **device\_is\_quiet** - manipulate device quiet flag

**DESCRIPTION**

Each device has a quiet flag associated with it. A device is verbose by default when it is created but may be quieted to prevent printing of the device identification string during attach and printing of a message during detach. To quiet a device, call **device\_quiet()** during a device driver probe routine. To re-enable probe messages, call **device\_verbose()**. To test to see if a device is quieted, call **device\_is\_quiet()**.

Devices are implicitly marked verbose after a driver detaches.
