

**NAME**

file\_raise() - controls raising of file\_read\_err and file\_write\_err

**SYNOPSIS**

**file\_raise(f,flag)**

**FILE \*f;**

**BOOL flag;**

**DESCRIPTION**

file\_raise() can be used to control whether the conditions "file\_read\_err" and "file\_write\_err" are raised when an error occurs during an I/O function ( fileread(), filewrite() , etc) on FILE f. Calling file\_raise() with the flag TRUE enables raising, calling it with flag FALSE disables raising. If raising is disabled and an error occurs the function will return an appropriate error code, this is equivalent to handling the condition and ignoring it. The default is to raise the conditions.
