NAME

from - print names of those who have sent mail

SYNOPSIS

from [-**c**] [-**f** file] [-**s** sender] [user]

DESCRIPTION

The **from** utility prints out the mail header lines from the invoker's mailbox.

The following options are available:

- -c Just print a count of messages and exit.
- **-f** *file* The supplied *file* is examined instead of the invoker's mailbox. If the **-f** option is used, the *user* argument should not be used. Read from standard input if file name "-" is given.
- -s sender

Only mail from addresses containing the supplied string are printed.

If *user* is given, the *user*'s mailbox is examined instead of the invoker's own mailbox. (Privileges are required.)

ENVIRONMENT

MAIL

If set, the location of the invoker's mailbox. Otherwise, the default in /var/mail is used.
