This function will modify or set a user or administrator's PIN for the given token. If it is called to set a PIN for first time the oldpin must be **NULL**. When setting the admin's PIN with the **GNUTLS\_PIN\_SO** flag, the *oldpin* value must be provided (this requirement is relaxed after GnuTLS 3.6.5 since which the PIN will be requested if missing).

# RETURNS

On success, GNUTLS\_E\_SUCCESS (0) is returned, otherwise a negative error value.
