### DESCRIPTION

This function will convert the given DER or PEM encoded PKCS7 to the native **gnutls\_pkcs7\_t** format. The output will be stored in

*pkcs7*. Any signed data that may be present inside the *pkcs7* structure, like certificates set by **gnutls\_pkcs7\_set\_crt(**), will be freed and overwritten by this function.

If the PKCS7 is PEM encoded it should have a header of "PKCS7".

### RETURNS

On success, GNUTLS\_E\_SUCCESS (0) is returned, otherwise a negative error value.
