# ARGUMENTS

gnutls\_psk\_server\_credentials\_t cred is a **gnutls\_psk\_server\_credentials\_t** type.

gnutls\_psk\_server\_credentials\_function2 func is the callback function

# DESCRIPTION

This function can be used to set a callback to retrieve the user's PSK credentials. The callback's function form is: int (\*callback)(gnutls\_session\_t, const gnutls\_datum\_t\* username, gnutls\_datum\_t\* key);

This callback function has the same semantics as that of **gnutls\_psk\_set\_server\_credentials\_function**(), but it allows non-string usernames to be used.

*username* contains the actual username. The *key* must be filled in using the **gnutls\_malloc**().

In case the callback returned a negative number then gnutls will assume that the username does not exist.

The callback function will only be called once per handshake. The callback function should return 0 on success, while -1 indicates an error.
