DESCRIPTION

If the session supports length-hiding padding, you can invoke <code>gnutls_record_send_range()</code> to send a message whose length is hidden in the given range. If the session does not support length hiding padding, you can use the standard <code>gnutls_record_send()</code> function, or <code>gnutls_record_send_range()</code> making sure that the range is the same as the length of the message you are trying to send.

RETURNS

true (1) if the current session supports length-hiding padding, false (0) if the current session does not.
