#### **DESCRIPTION**

This function will pretty print a X.509 certificate, suitable for display to a human.

If the format is **GNUTLS\_CRT\_PRINT\_FULL** then all fields of the certificate will be output, on multiple lines. The **GNUTLS\_CRT\_PRINT\_ONELINE** format will generate one line with some selected fields, which is useful for logging purposes.

The output *out* needs to be deallocated using **gnutls\_free**().

## **RETURNS**

On success, GNUTLS\_E\_SUCCESS (0) is returned, otherwise a negative error value.
