gsl-config - script to get version number and compiler flags of the installed GSL library

DESCRIPTION

gsl-config is a tool that is used to configure to determine the compiler and linker flags that should be used to compile and link programs that use *GSL*. It is also used internally to the .m4 macros for GNU autoconf that are included with *GSL*.

OPTIONS

gsl-config accepts the following options:

- **--version** Print the currently installed version of *GSL* on the standard output.
- --libs Print the linker flags that are necessary to link a GSL program, with cblas

--libs-without-cblas

Print the linker flags that are necessary to link a GSL program, without cblas

- **--cflags** Print the compiler flags that are necessary to compile a GSL program.
- **--prefix** Show the GSL installation prefix.
