mariadb_reconnect - reconnects to a server

Synopsis

#include <mysql.h>
```

my_bool mariadb_reconnect(MYSQL * mysql)
```

Description

mariadb_reconnect() tries to reconnect to a server in case the connection died due to timeout or other errors. It uses the same credentials which were specified in **mysql_real_connect(3)**.

Return value

The function will return 0 on success, a non zero value on error

Note: The function will return an error, if the option `MYSQL_OPT_RECONNECT` wasn't set before.

mariadb_reconnect() was added in MariaDB Connector/C 3.0
