**mate-volume-control** - The MATE Volume Control application

## SYNOPSIS

**mate-volume-control** [OPTIONS]

## DESCRIPTION

The MATE Volume Control application is an audio mixer that enables you to mix audio and adjust volume levels of various audio mixer devices on your system.

## OPTIONS

**-b, --backend=pulse|alsa|oss|null**

Launch **mate-volume-control** with the selected sound system backend.

**-d, --debug**

Enable debugging code.

**-p, --page=effects|hardware|input|output|applications**

Launch **mate-volume-control** on the specified page/tab.

**-v, --version**

Output version information and exit.

**--display=DISPLAY**

X display to use.

**-, -h, --help**

Print standard command line options.

**--help-all**

Print all command line options.

This program also accepts the standard GTK+ options.

**--help-gtk**

Print GTK+ options.
