mount\_udf - mount a UDF file system

# **SYNOPSIS**

mount\_udf [-v] [-o options] [-C charset] special node

# **DESCRIPTION**

The **mount\_udf** utility attaches the UDF file system residing on the device *special* to the global file system namespace at the location indicated by *node*.

The options are as follows:

- -o Options are specified with a -o flag followed by a comma separated string of options. See the mount(8) man page for possible options and their meanings. The following UDF specific options are available:
- -v Be verbose about mounting the UDF file system.

### -C charset

Specify local *charset* to convert Unicode file names.
