mysql_commit - Commits the current transaction

Synopsis

```
#include <mysql.h>
```

```
my_bool mysql_commit(MYSQL * mysql);
```

Description

Commits the current transaction for the specified database connection. Returns zero on success, nonzero if an error occurred.

Parameters

- ⊕ mysql is a connection identifier, which was previously allocated by **mysql_init(3)** and connected by **mysql_real_connect(3)**.

Notes

Executing mysql_commit() will not affected the behaviour of autocommit. This means, any update or insert statements following mysql_commit() will be rolled back when the connection gets closed.
