mysql_fetch_lengths - returns an array of length values for the current row

Synopsis

```
#include <mysql.h>

unsigned long * mysql_fetch_lengths(MYSQL_RES * result);
```

Description

The mysql_fetch_lengths() function returns an array containing the lengths of every column of the current row within the result set (not including terminating zero character) or NULL if an error occurred.

Parameter

⊕ `result` - a result set identifier returned by **mysql_store_result(3)** or **mysql_use_result(3)**. ### Notes
mysql_fetch_lengths() is valid only for the current row of the result set. It returns NULL if you call it before calling **mysql_fetch_row(3)** or after retrieving all rows in the result.

Return value

An array of unsigned long values . The size of the array can be determined by the number of fields in current result set.
