mysql_more_results - indicates if one or more results are available

Synopsis

```
#include <mysql.h>
```

```
my_bool mysql_more_results(MYSQL * mysql);
```

Description

Indicates if one or more result sets are available from a previous call to **mysql_real_query(3)**.

Parameter

- ⊕ mysql - a connection identifier, which was previously allocated by **mysql_init(3)** and connected by **mysql_real_connect(3)**.

Notes

- ⊕ The function **mysql_set_server_option(3)** enables or disables multi statement support.
- ⊕ Multiple result sets can be obtained either by calling a stored procedure or by executing concatenated statements, e.g. `SELECT a FROM t1;SELECT b, c FROM t2.`

Return value

Returns 1 if more result sets are available, otherwise zero.
