Description

Returns number of rows in a result set.

Parameters

⊕ **MYSQL_RES** - a result set identifier returned by **mysql_store_result(3)** or **mysql_use_result(3)**. ###

Notes The behaviour of mysql_num_rows() depends on whether buffered or unbuffered result sets are being used. For unbuffered result sets, mysql_num_rows() will not return the correct number of rows until all the rows in the result have been retrieved.
