**Description**

Returns number of rows in a result set.

**Parameters**

- ⊕ **MYSQL\_RES** - a result set identifier returned by **mysql\_store\_result(3)** or **mysql\_use\_result(3)**. ###  
Notes The behaviour of mysql\_num\_rows() depends on whether buffered or unbuffered result sets are being used. For unbuffered result sets, mysql\_num\_rows() will not return the correct number of rows until all the rows in the result have been retrieved.
