`mysql_options4` - Used to set extra connect options and affect behavior of a connection

Synopsis

#include <mysql.h>

int mysql_options4(MYSQL * mysql,
                   enum mysql_option,
                   const void * arg1,
                   const void * arg2);
```

Description

Used to set extra connect options and affect behavior for a connection. This function may be called multiple times to set several options. `mysql_options()` should be called after `mysql_init(3)`.

Notes

This function is deprecated, new implementations should use `mysql_optionsv(3)` api function instead.
