mysql_shutdown - Sends shutdown message to server

Synopsis

int mysql_shutdown(MYSQL * mysql,
                  enum mysql_enum_shutdown_level);
```

Description

This function is deprecated. Instead please use SQL SHUTDOWN command.

Sends a shutdown message to the server.

Parameter

- ⊕ mysql - a mysql handle, which was previously allocated by **mysql_init(3)** and connected by **mysql_real_connect(3)**.
- ⊕ mysql_enum_shutdown_level - currently only one shutdown level, SHUTDOWN_DEFAULT is supported.

Notes

- ⊕ To shutdown the database server, the user for the current connection must have SHUTDOWN privileges.

Return value

Returns zero on success, non-zero on failure.
