mysql_stat - Returns current server status

Synopsis

```
#include <mysql.h>
```

const char * mysql_stat(MYSQL * mysql);
```

Description

mysql_stat() returns a string with the current server status for uptime, threads, queries, open tables, flush tables and queries per second.

Parameter

- ⊕ mysql - a mysql handle, which was previously allocated by **mysql_init(3)** and connected by **mysql_real_connect(3)**.

Notes

For a complete list of other status variables, you have to use the [show-status()](SHOW STATUS)] SQL command.

Return value

Returns a string representing current server status.
