

**Name**

mysql\_stmt\_bind\_result - binds result columns to variables

**Synopsis**

```
#include <mysql.h>
```

```
my_bool mysql_stmt_bind_result(MYSQL_STMT * stmt,  
                               MYSQL_BIND * bind);
```

**Description**

Binds columns in the result set to variables. Returns zero on success, non-zero on failure.

**Parameters**

- ⊕ stmt - a statement handle, which was previously allocated by **mysql\_stmt\_init(3)**.
- ⊕ bind - an array of [MYSQL\_BIND]] structures. The size of this array must be equal to the number of columns in result set.

**Notes**

- ⊕ To determine the number of columns in result set use **mysql\_stmt\_field\_count(3)**.
- ⊕ A column can be bound or rebound at any time, even after a result set has been partially retrieved. The new binding takes effect the next time **mysql\_stmt\_fetch(3)** is called.
