

Name

mysql_stmt_more_results - indicates if one or more results from a previously executed prepared statement are available

Synopsis

```
#include <mysql.h>
```

```
my_bool mysql_stmt_more_results(MYSQL_STMT * stmt);
```

Description

Indicates if one or more result sets are available from a previous call to **mysql_stmt_execute(3)**.

Parameter

- ⊕ stmt - a statement handle, which was previously allocated by mysql_stmt_init() (mysql_init) and executed by **mysql_stmt_execute(3)**.

Notes

- ⊕ Multiple result sets can be obtained by calling a stored procedure. Executing concatenated statements is not supported in prepared statement protocol.

Return value

Returns 1 if more result sets are available, otherwise zero.
