

**Name**

mysql\_stmt\_more\_results - indicates if one or more results from a previously executed prepared statement are available

**Synopsis**

```
#include <mysql.h>
```

```
my_bool mysql_stmt_more_results(MYSQL_STMT * stmt);
```

**Description**

Indicates if one or more result sets are available from a previous call to **mysql\_stmt\_execute(3)**.

**Parameter**

- ⊕ stmt - a statement handle, which was previously allocated by mysql\_stmt\_init() (mysql\_init) and executed by **mysql\_stmt\_execute(3)**.

**Notes**

- ⊕ Multiple result sets can be obtained by calling a stored procedure. Executing concatenated statements is not supported in prepared statement protocol.

**Return value**

Returns 1 if more result sets are available, otherwise zero.
