# **Description**

Returns the number of rows in the result set. The use of mysql\_stmt\_num\_rows() depends on whether or not you used mysql\_stmt\_store\_result(3) to buffer the entire result set in the statement handle.

#### **Parameter**

• stmt - a statement handle, which was previously allocated by mysql\_stmt\_init(3).
