mysql\_stmt\_num\_rows - Returns number of rows in a prepared statement result set

**Synopsis**

```
#include <mysql.h>
```

unsigned long long mysql_stmt_num_rows(MYSQL_STMT * stmt);
```

**Description**

Returns the number of rows in the result set. The use of `mysql_stmt_num_rows()` depends on whether or not you used **mysql\_stmt\_store\_result(3)** to buffer the entire result set in the statement handle.

**Parameter**

⊕ `stmt` - a statement handle, which was previously allocated by **mysql\_stmt\_init(3)**.

**Return value**

Number of rows in the result set

**Notes**

⊕ If you use **mysql\_stmt\_store\_result(3)**, `mysql_stmt_num_rows()` may be called immediately.
