**Description**

Returns the number of warnings from the last executed statement, or zero if there are no warnings. ##  
Parameter \* stmt - a statement handle, which was previously allocated by **mysql\_stmt\_init(3)**.

**Return value**

Returns the number of warnings.

**Notes**

- ⊕ For retrieving warning messages you should use the SQL command SHOW WARNINGS.
- ⊕ If SQL\_MODE TRADITIONAL is enabled an error instead of warning will be returned. For detailed information check the server documentation. ## History This function was added in Connector/C 3.0.
