mysql_thread_id - Returns id of the current connection

Synopsis

Description

The `mysql_thread_id()` function returns the thread id for the current connection.

Parameter

- ⊕ `mysql` - a mysql handle, which was previously allocated by **mysql_init(3)** and connected by **mysql_real_connect(3)**. ### Notes
- ⊕ The current connection can be killed with **mysql_kill(3)**.
- ⊕ If reconnect option is enabled the thread id might change if the client reconnects to the server.

Return value

Returns the thread id of the current connection.
