mysql_warning_count - Returns the number of warnings

Synopsis

```
#include <mysql.h>
```

unsigned int mysql_warning_count(MYSQL * mysql);
```

Description

Returns the number of warnings from the last executed query, or zero if there are no warnings.

Parameter

⊕ mysql - a mysql handle, which was previously allocated by **mysql_init(3)** and connected by **mysql_real_connect(3)**.

Notes

- ⊕ For retrieving warning messages you should use the SQL command SHOW WARNINGS.
- ⊕ If SQL_MODE TRADITIONAL is enabled an error instead of warning will be returned. For detailed information check the server documentation.

Return value

Returns the number of warnings
