## **SYNOPSIS**

## **DESCRIPTION**

The Deny authentication service module for PAM, **pam\_deny** provides functionality for all the PAM categories: authentication, account management, session management and password management. In terms of the *module-type* parameter, these are the "auth", "account", "session", and "password" features.

The Deny module will universally deny all requests. It is primarily of use during testing, and to "null-out" unwanted functionality.

The following options may be passed to the module:

**debug** syslog(3) debugging information at LOG\_DEBUG level.

**no\_warn** suppress warning messages to the user. These messages include reasons why the user's authentication attempt was declined.
