The **pam\_info()** function displays an informational message through the intermediary of the given PAM context's conversation function.

The **pam\_info()** function returns one of the following values:

[PAM\_SUCCESS]     Success.

[PAM\_BUF\_ERR]     Memory buffer error.

[PAM\_CONV\_ERR]    Conversation failure.

[PAM\_SYSTEM\_ERR]
