pam_lastlog - login accounting PAM module

SYNOPSIS

[*service-name*] *module-type control-flag pam_lastlog [options]*

DESCRIPTION

The login accounting service module for PAM, **pam_lastlog** provides functionality for only one PAM category: session management. In terms of the *module-type* parameter, this is the "session" feature.

Login Accounting Session Management Module

The login accounting session management component provides functions to initiate (**pam_sm_open_session()**) and terminate (**pam_sm_close_session()**) sessions. The **pam_sm_open_session()** function records the session in the user accounting database. The **pam_sm_close_session()** function does nothing.

The following options may be passed to the authentication module:

debug syslog(3) debugging information at LOG_DEBUG level.

no_warn suppress warning messages to the user.

no_fail Ignore I/O failures.
