# DESCRIPTION

The **pmap\_init**() function initializes the pmap(9) sub-system. It is called during system initialization by **vm\_init**(), to initialize any structures that the **pmap\_init** system needs in order to map between physical and virtual memory.

The **pmap\_init2**() function initializes a zone for the PV entries. These are used to implement page sharing at the physical level. A high water mark is set so that the system can recover from excessive numbers of PV entries.
