DESCRIPTION

Returns the name or version of the locale for the category specified by *mask*. The possible values for the mask are the same as those in newlocale(3), when requesting the locale name. Specify the bitwise OR of *LC_VERSION_MASK* and another mask value to request a version string. Version strings can be compared to detect changes to the locale's definition. The structure of the version string is unspecified. Currently, version information is only available for *LC_COLLATE_MASK*, and an empty string is returned for other categories. If more than one bit in the mask is set, not counting *LC_VERSION_MASK*, the returned value is undefined.
