

NAME

querylocale - Look up the locale name or version for a specified category

LIBRARY

Standard C Library (libc, -lc)

SYNOPSIS

DESCRIPTION

Returns the name or version of the locale for the category specified by *mask*. The possible values for the mask are the same as those in `newlocale(3)`, when requesting the locale name. Specify the bitwise OR of `LC_VERSION_MASK` and another mask value to request a version string. Version strings can be compared to detect changes to the locale's definition. The structure of the version string is unspecified. Currently, version information is only available for `LC_COLLATE_MASK`, and an empty string is returned for other categories. If more than one bit in the mask is set, not counting `LC_VERSION_MASK`, the returned value is undefined.

HISTORY

The `querylocale()` function first appeared in FreeBSD 9.1, and is based on the function of the same name in Darwin. `LC_VERSION_MASK` first appeared in FreeBSD 13.0.
