rwho - who is logged in on local machines

#### **SYNOPSIS**

rwho [-a]

#### DESCRIPTION

The **rwho** command produces output similar to who(1), but for all machines on the local network. If no report has been received from a machine for 11 minutes then **rwho** assumes the machine is down, and does not report users last known to be logged into that machine.

If a user has not typed to the system for a minute or more, then **rwho** reports this idle time.

The following option is available:

-a Include all users. By default, if a user has not typed to the system for an hour or more, then the user will be omitted from the output.
