void unw_destroy_addr_space(unw_addr_space_t as);
```

# **DESCRIPTION**

The unw\_destroy\_addr\_space() routine destroys the address space specified by argument as and thereby releases all associated resources (such as memory).

Applications must not destroy the local address space unw\_local\_addr\_space. Attempting to do so results in undefined behavior (e.g., the application may crash).
