EVENT FIELDS

response_type The type of this event, in this case *XCB_DESTROY_NOTIFY*. This field is also present in the *xcb_generic_event_t* and can be used to tell events apart from each other.

sequence The sequence number of the last request processed by the X11 server.

event The reconfigured window or its parent, depending on whether *StructureNotify* or *SubstructureNotify* was selected.

window The window that is destroyed.
