REQUEST ARGUMENTS

conn The XCB connection to X11.

REPLY FIELDS

response_type The type of this reply, in this case *XCB_INPUT_LIST_INPUT_DEVICES*. This field is also present in the *xcb_generic_reply_t* and can be used to tell replies apart from each other.

sequence The sequence number of the last request processed by the X11 server.

length The length of the reply, in words (a word is 4 bytes).

xi_reply_type TODO: NOT YET DOCUMENTED.

devices_len TODO: NOT YET DOCUMENTED.

DESCRIPTION

RETURN VALUE

Returns an *xcb_input_list_input_devices_cookie_t*. Errors have to be handled when calling the reply function *xcb_input_list_input_devices_reply*.

If you want to handle errors in the event loop instead, use *xcb_input_list_input_devices_unchecked*.
