

NAME

xcb_list_fonts - get matching font names

SYNOPSIS

Request function

```
xcb_list_fonts_cookie_t xcb_list_fonts(xcb_connection_t *conn, uint16_t max_names,
    uint16_t pattern_len, const char *pattern);
```

Reply datastructure

```
typedef struct xcb_list_fonts_reply_t {
    uint8_t response_type;
    uint8_t pad0;
    uint16_t sequence;
    uint32_t length;
    uint16_t names_len;
    uint8_t pad1[22];
} xcb_list_fonts_reply_t;
```

Reply function

```
xcb_list_fonts_reply_t *xcb_list_fonts_reply(xcb_connection_t *conn, xcb_list_fonts_cookie_t cookie,
    xcb_generic_error_t **e);
```

Reply accessors

```
int xcb_list_fonts_names_length(const xcb_list_fonts_reply_t *reply);
```

xcb_str_iterator_t xcb_list_fonts_names_iterator(const xcb_list_fonts_reply_t *reply);
```

REQUEST ARGUMENTS

conn The XCB connection to X11.

max_names The maximum number of fonts to be returned.

pattern_len The length (in bytes) of *pattern*.

pattern A font pattern, for example "-misc-fixed-*".

The asterisk (*) is a wildcard for any number of characters. The question mark (?) is a

wildcard for a single character. Use of uppercase or lowercase does not matter.

REPLY FIELDS

response_type The type of this reply, in this case *XCB_LIST_FONTS*. This field is also present in the *xcb_generic_reply_t* and can be used to tell replies apart from each other.

sequence The sequence number of the last request processed by the X11 server.

length The length of the reply, in words (a word is 4 bytes).

names_len The number of font names.

DESCRIPTION

Gets a list of available font names which match the given *pattern*.

RETURN VALUE

Returns an *xcb_list_fonts_cookie_t*. Errors have to be handled when calling the reply function *xcb_list_fonts_reply*.

If you want to handle errors in the event loop instead, use *xcb_list_fonts_unchecked*. See **xcb-requests(3)** for details.

ERRORS

This request does never generate any errors.
