**REQUEST ARGUMENTS**

*conn*           The XCB connection to X11.

*window*         TODO: NOT YET DOCUMENTED.

**REPLY FIELDS**

*response\_type*   The type of this reply, in this case `XCB_SELINUX_LIST_PROPERTIES`. This field is also present in the `xcb_generic_reply_t` and can be used to tell replies apart from each other.

*sequence*      The sequence number of the last request processed by the X11 server.

*length*        The length of the reply, in words (a word is 4 bytes).

*properties\_len*    TODO: NOT YET DOCUMENTED.

### RETURN VALUE

Returns an *xcb\_selinux\_list\_properties\_cookie\_t*. Errors have to be handled when calling the reply function *xcb\_selinux\_list\_properties\_reply*.

If you want to handle errors in the event loop instead, use *xcb\_selinux\_list\_properties\_unchecked*. See **xcb-requests(3)** for details.
